## Guidelines of Economic Rights

- I. *Journal of Teacher Education and Professional Development* ( hereinafter referred to as the Journal ) is a academic journal published with the grants from Ministry of Education. Hence, this guideline regulated by our editorial committee is aimed particularly at aspects related to editing and reviewing of economic rights of the papers related.
- II. The work submitted has to be original without being ever submitted or accepted for publication either in other journals elsewhere, conference proceedings or in print. Manuscripts submitted to any other journal simultaneously, infringing copyright or violating academic ethics are not considered.
- III. The suspension of papers or deprived of the right of publishing for papers during the review process by members of Editorial Committee takes effect under the violations against Article 4 or 5 of the guidelines. Submitted manuscripts that have been reviewed by referees and accepted for publication by the Editorial Committee of the Journal cannot be withdrawn unless such withdrawal of manuscripts is subjected to the agreement of the editorial committee.
- IV. Application for withdrawal of manuscripts from the Editorial Committee is subject to the following conditions:
  - (i.) The Author admits that Article 2 of the guidelines is violated or plagiarism is involved.
  - (ii.) The Author claims the work submitted contains severe academic errors in academics or theory.
  - (iii.) Application for withdrawal of manuscripts is allowed when the revised manuscripts are not based on reviewer's comment or when the consensus by reviewers and the author is not reached on the explanation of the revision which the author refuses to revise again.
- V. Submitted or published manuscripts that violate Article 2 of guidelines or plagiarism will be rejected or an official notification will be made after such violation is proved and determined by the Editorial Committee of the Journal.
- VI. Official notification in written form must be delivered to authors by the Editorial Committee concerning determinations in accordance with Article 4 or 5 of the guidelines.
- VII. Should the Editorial Committee of the Journal decides to accept papers for publication, the "Copyright Transfer Agreement " must be signed by the author and return to the Journal.
- VIII. As the guidelines passed in the meeting of the Editorial Committee takes effect, so does the amendment of the guidelines.
